


NUMBERS 16:41-50

Without fire:

Loss of worship - performance/entertainment Religion instead of relationship; rituals instead of reasons - impersonal God Grumbling, complaining – 'me-centric' Fighting with leadership, disagreeing, blaming - no spiritual alignment





God is a consuming fire (Hebrews 12:29) The fire of God consumes and destroys The fire of God will consume sin, everything that is not from God

The difference is where we are when the fire comes

The fire of God consumes us so that we can be fully aligned to God and His ways





The fire of God consumes, then consecrates us Consecration makes us holy and sets us apart

Consecration takes what is in our hands and transforms it for His purpose



The fire of God purifies, transforms, strengthens, and then consecrates us for His Purpose
