- Living in the vicinity of Bethlehem
- Important in Jewish culture but not respected
- Often overlooked/marginalized
- Represent the marginalized/overlooked in our world



We must never allow the lines drawn by the world and culture to determine the extent of our outreach



THE MAGI



Common misconceptions

- Thought to be kings
- Assumed to be three because there were three gifts
- Often part of the nativity scene in postcards and pictures

THE MAGI



- Most likely from Persia
- Astrologers likely influenced by Daniel
- Represent people who are genuinely seeking



God speaks to us in a way we understand

HEROD



- Roman ruler over Jerusalem and the Jews
- Known to be a builder but also a harsh ruler
- Encountered the Magi who went to his palace in search for the king

HEROD



- Disturbed by this news
- Sought teachers of the law and met with the Magiton to kill off the threat to this throne
- Represents people who are antagonistic or opposed to Jesus and the Gospel



The burden to reach the lost must outweigh the fear of a negative response to the Gospel
